 - The consultant shall recommend project(s), including projected costs, that the Town can implement in permit term 2023-2028 in order to meet our impervious restoration target.
 - For example, the Town expects to retrofit the Northgate residential development storm water management basin in the 2023-2028 term.
- 2. Will the Town provide GIS data of the current baseline impervious assessment?
 - Yes.
- 3. Are the bidders required to submit a total cost in the bidding package in order for the consultant to complete Phase 1 Storm Water Utility Feasibility Study?
 - Yes.

 - The bills go out to property owners quarterly and includes water, sewer, and trash.
- 7. Will the consultant be required to create educational materials for the public?
 - Yes. The consultant shall identify activities to be used to support and promote storm water program development, policies, and financial plan. This may include brochures, pamphlets, social media and/or public presentations for community meetings and workshops.
- 8. Will GIS data of the Town's stormwater management system be available to the consultant?
 - Yes.

- 9. Will the Town hold stakeholder advisory committee meetings?
 - Yes. The consultant shall, at the Town's option, participate in up to 10 presentations to Town staff, elected officials, and/or general public interest groups. It is expected that the consultant will run these meetings.
- 10. Will the consultant be required to include operational costs, in addition to capital costs, in the annual SWM utility budget estimates for years 2023-2028?
 - Yes.
- 11. What is the Town's current impervious acre restoration target required by MDE?
 - 20.452 acres
 - We expect the same or very similar target for our next permit term of 2023-2028.
- 12. When does the Town expect to implement the storm water utility?
 - It is the Town's desire to implement the utility by the start of the next MS4 permit term, which is July 1, 2023.
